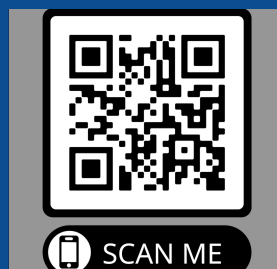
College of Wooster Basketball Game

Leader in Me: Habit 5- Seek First to Understand, Then to be Understood

This means that it is better to listen first and talk second. By taking the time to listen to another person, you get better communication. Teaching Habit #5 to young children is best approached by introducing listening as a skill that should be practiced. Learning to listen without interrupting and learning to listen with your ears, your eyes, and your heart will help children really understand Habit #5.
