### **Dismissal Procedures**

<u>Walkers:</u> Students walking home are dismissed from Door 3. The preschool parking lot is closed during dismissal. Please do not park in this lot to pick up your child from the walker door.

<u>Car Loop:</u> Students leaving in the car loop must be picked up by a vehicle. Please do not walk to the door to pick up your child. Pull as far forward as possible to allow us to load multiple cars at a time. To ensure quick identification, have your car tag displayed in your window at all times. Anyone not recognized, will be asked to provide photo ID.
