FAQs

Q: What is the Generals' Academy (GA)?

A: The Generals' Academy is a program within the Wooster City School District that is designed to meet the needs of students who prefer to learn primarily in a blended environment. This program offers a full range of online courses for students in grades K-12.

Q: Who teaches the courses in the GA?

A: The GA has a very diverse and highly qualified staff of content specialists. Our staff specializes in online instruction and personalizing the learning experience for our students. Currently we have one instructor from each of the four core content areas at the high school level: English/Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies; an Intervention Specialist and a Program Coordinator who also assists students with elective courses. Information regarding the middle school and elementary level programs will be available soon.

Q: My child currently is enrolled in an Ohio Virtual School. Is this program similar?

A: The GA is not an e-school, but rather a program within the Wooster City School District. It offers flexible scheduling and small group environments for students.

Q: What are the advantages of the GA?

A: The GA allows students to individualize and personalize how they learn, but is also offers the accessibility of a world class staff and facility for assistance. All GA students also have full access to co-curriculars and extra-curriculars (pending they meet academic requirements) within the Wooster City School District.

Q: Do I need a computer and Internet access to participate in the GA from my residence?

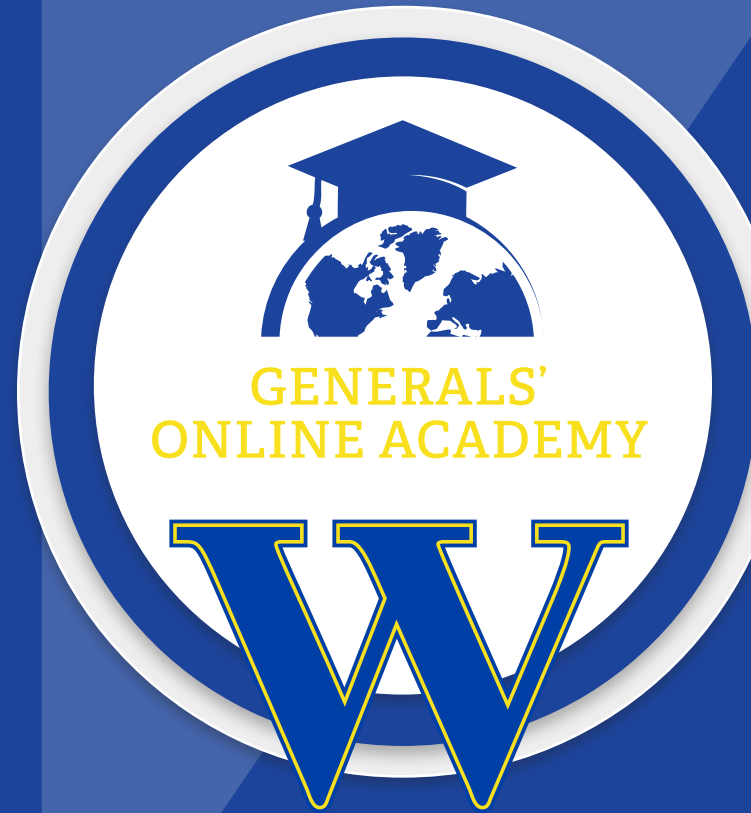
A: Yes. However, students who do not have a device to use can lease a device. There is no charge to lease a device.
