WOOSTER SCHOOLS' BOND ISSUE FAILS

WOOSTER, OH (May 3rd, 2023) — On May 2nd, voters rejected the proposed bond issue that would have generated \$102,086,000 to fund the construction of a new 6-8 Middle School and a new Pre-K-2 Elementary School.

"We understand that the levy failure has an impact on the execution of our Facilities Master Plan, but we want to assure the community that we remain committed to working together to achieve our goals and meet the needs of our students," said Superintendent Gabe Tudor. "The priority of providing our students with a top-of-the-line education that prepares them for a successful future remains in our district."

The district will continue to engage with the community to maintain an open line of communication and ensure transparency. Wooster City Schools will regularly evaluate existing safety measures to provide students with a secure learning environment. "We are always seeking the best ways to determine how we can better serve our community, parents, and students," Tudor added. "We will continue seeking feedback over the coming months to identify and address our district's needs and goals as we move forward."
