#### Application Deadlines:

- Submit Letter of Intent to your school counselor - April 1
- Complete AU's online application:
  - Summer Term - March 1
  - Fall Semester - May 15
  - Spring Semester - Oct 15
- Submit Mature Content Paper - May 15

#### Admission Requirements

- Pathway 1: Traditional Admission Requirements - Minimum 2.50 cumulative high school GPA, plus one of the following assessment scores:
  - 18 ACT Composite
  - 970 SAT
  - Or ONE of the following Accuplacer scores
    - 250 Reading
    - 263 Writing
    - 263 Quantitative Reasoning, Algebra and Statistics (QRS)
- Pathway 2: AU Test-Optional Admission Requirements
  - Minimum 3.0 unweighted cumulative high school GPA or
  - 2.85-2.99 GPA with grades of "A" or "B" in math, English, science and social studies

# Financial Counseling Form

College Credit Plus is free for all public-school students who wish to attend a public Ohio university or college. That means no cost for tuition, books or fees if you attend public school in the state of Ohio. If you choose to attend a private college, you may have limited costs.

Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 3365.09(A), a district may seek reimbursement from a student or parent if the student fails to attain a passing final grade. Current interpretation of this statute shall allow, but not require, a school district or nonpublic school as appropriate to seek reimbursement under the following two circumstances: 1) If the student receives a failing grade at the end of the college course; or 2) If the student withdraws from or drops the college course subsequent to the 14th calendar day after the particular course began. Pursuant to Section 3365.09(C), neither a school district nor a nonpublic school shall seek reimbursement if the student is identified as being economically disadvantaged in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code 3333-1-65.6(B)(2).

By signing you are acknowledging you will be financially responsible if you child fails the course or withdraws past the deadline.
