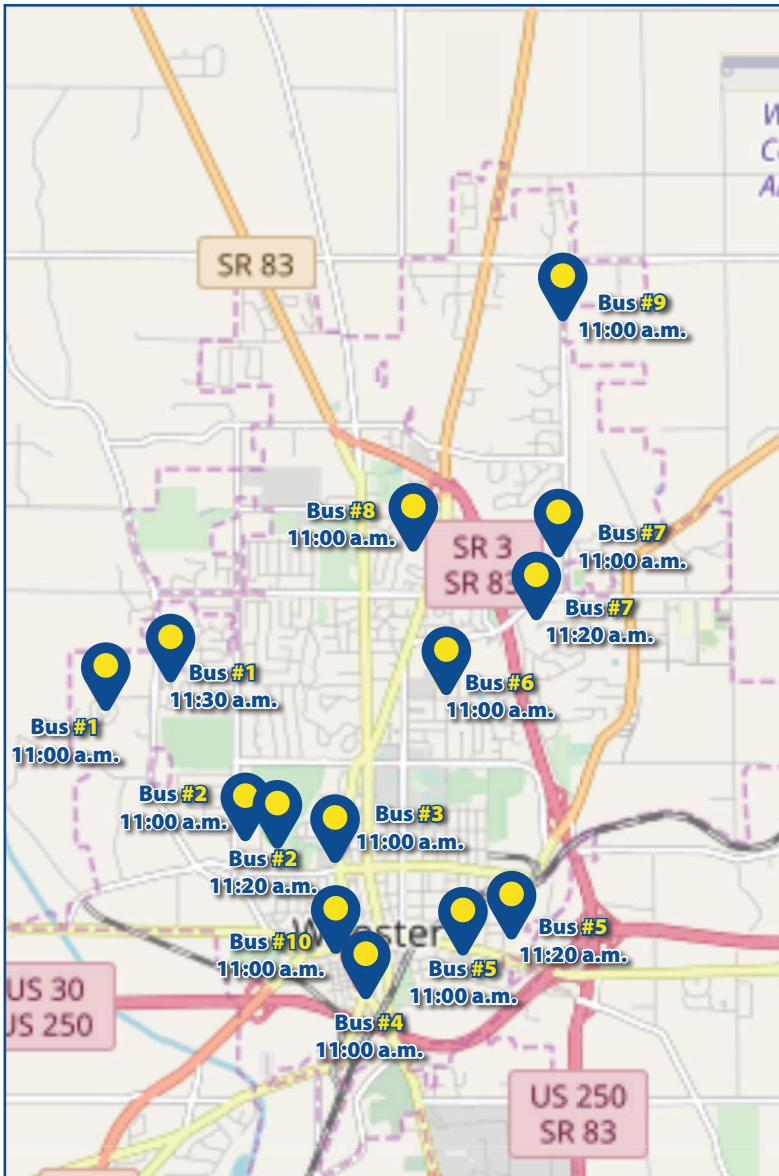


FOOD DISTRIBUTION

As a result of Governor DeWine's decision Thursday to close all K-12 buildings throughout the state of Ohio, the Wooster City School District will continue to provide breakfast and lunch to qualifying students for the duration of the school closure.

The district will have **10 buses** that will be stopping at **14 different locations** throughout Wooster. Busses will stop and stay at each location for 15 minutes to ensure that all students receive meals.
