• "At the time, Wooster City School District offered a program called Distributive Education which allowed individuals to work a half day if they had the credits required to graduate. This helped jump-start my career path, as I worked as an assistant manager in the shoe department for a business called "Buckeye Mart" (similar to Wal-Mart these days). Shortly after one year of service, I was promoted to manager status at a location in Mount Vernon, OH. After three years, I changed careers and started with Columbia Gas Transmission in 1971 in which I worked various levels as a laborer, technician and manager before retiring some years later."
