Amy Welty was born and raised in Wooster and is a graduate of Wooster High School. She earned her BA in Accounting from the University of Mount Union and earned her MA in Community College Management from Antioch University in 2008. Welty received her State of Ohio Department of Education School Treasurer license in 2019.

Welty worked at Stark State College from 2001 to 2019, beginning as Director of Financial Aid. In 2007, she became Executive Director of Financial Aid, Registration and Enrollment Operations at Stark State College and, in that position, she supervised 25 staff members in the Financial Aid and Enrollment Operations departments while also designing and implementing system overhauls and technology initiatives. Welty was also responsible for \$100 million in federal, state, external and institutional awards; hundreds of thousands of official student records; and over 50 course catalogs.

Most previously, Welty was the Business Administrator for Wayne County Job and Family Services (WCJFS).
