- Fee could be applied to the following:
  - Purchase of equipment:
    - Video Cameras (\$700), Batteries for Cameras (\$50), Microphones (\$190), Tripods (\$75), SD Cards (\$20), Camera Cases (\$150)
  - Repair/Maintenance of equipment
    - At least one piece of equipment per semester requires maintenance, based on student usage\*.

*\*Student Usage - students use video equipment daily in class and also have the ability to sign out equipment to take home to work on video production projects related to the course.*

*\* TV Production is a course that focuses on the creation of weekly video announcements that will be broadcast to the school. Students who have taken this course multiple times (much like band), and who show great responsibility are given the opportunity to work with district personnel and outside businesses to create videos as requested. Students are expected to individually create 3 segments per nine weeks. Students are expected to work outside of class to obtain the necessary video to produce their segments. All videos created by students for video announcements are considered school property until the videos have been aired in class and given feedback by students and staff. After that, all videos created for video announcements are considered student property. Any work completed for an outside entity is considered property of the client, but may be used in a portfolio for the student.*
